Dear Parents and Guardians,

We, the Narre Warren North School Council, on behalf of our Principal, Assistant Principal and school community would like to add 5 buddy benches to our school displaying our school values on each bench similar to the image below. We are asking families and their businesses to be part of this awesome addition.



If you haven't heard of buddy benches, the purpose is to provide a safe place for children to go to during recess and lunchtimes when they can't find friends to play with. Children will then be educated that if they see anyone sitting alone on these benches to approach them and ask them to join in an activity. It is also a visual aid to help teachers be aware of potential social issues children may be having and provide any support and guidance required to help them through any difficulties.

So many recent studies are showing many children now suffering anxiety and depression from a young age and things like feeling as if they don't have friends can be a huge contributing factor in these feelings. Narre Warren North Primary School has a very inclusive school community. Having these buddy benches will reinforce these values to all children and peace of mind for parents knowing our children have a place to go if they are feeling alone and that there will be immediate support for them without the children actually having to tell anyone how they are feeling, which can often be the hardest thing for them to admit.

We are looking for families, their businesses or other members of the local community to contribute toward the purchase, delivery and installation of these benches. Each bench costs approximately \$1000. All contributions will receive a receipt from the school Building Fund, which will make their contribution tax deductible.

Contributions of up to \$100.00 will be acknowledged in the newsletter; for donations between \$100 and \$200 your name or business will be engraved on a plaque and attached to a bench; and for donations over \$200 an individual plaque with your logo and business or family name will be attached to the seat. These seats are made from 100% recycled plastics making the purchase of these benches great for the environment as well.

All contributions can be made via QKR!, together with details of the name to be added to the plaque, whether it is a business or family name.

We are unbelievably proud to be part of this endeavour for our school and hope you will be as excited as we are about being involved.
