At Narre Warren North Primary School it is important to us that all children feel happy and secure. Our school aims for all children to reach their full potential in a supportive learning community where students are motivated and challenged to become independent and successful learners.

To help achieve this we are providing a Pathway to Prep Program for enrolled 2020 Prep students. The aim of this program is to provide your child with a smooth, enjoyable and secure start into school.

Parents are welcome to settle their child at the beginning of the session to ensure they feel confident within the classroom.
