2020 enrolments and online website

This term we will be confirming enrolments for students outside our neighbourhood zone. If you have a child starting next year in Prep I strongly advise you to enrol now if you haven't already.

The Department has released a new website that helps parents identify their local public school online. **Findmyschool.vic.gov.au** was launched on 24th April and shows every school zone across the state. The new website highlights the choice of public schools available to the Victorian community.

Children of school age have the right to be enrolled at their designated neighbourhood school. If your child is already enrolled, you do not need to do anything further. Your child will maintain his/her existing enrolment. If your child is beginning Year 7 in 2020 this website will assist you in locating public schools close to where you live.

Parents can still request enrolment at a school that is not their designated neighbourhood school. That school, however can only accept your enrolment if there is sufficient capacity at the school. If a school has some capacity like ours, but not enough to fit everyone from outside its zone, the school uses DET's Placement Policy to determine enrolments.
