Principal Pen

Monday 25th is a pupil free day so **no** children will be allowed at school including those children who are currently coming to school. All teachers will be onsite and there will not be a teaching plan for the day.

As you are aware the Grade Prep to 2 students will be returning to school next Tuesday 26th May. Children in Grades 3 to 6 will still be required to learn remotely from home supported by their classroom teachers. The return date for Grade 3 to 6 students is Tuesday 9th June.

Students in Prep to Grade 2 coming back to school next week will need to return their chromebooks to school on Tuesday 26th May. Teachers will be checking these as they are returned to ensure that they are in good condition as per the agreement parents signed. The Department has indicated that there will be no remote learning for Prep to Grade 2 students from next week.

Parents of Grade Prep to 2 children will need to drop off their children at their start time as outlined below. We ask that parents stay in the car park and watch their children cross the manned crossing. Parents are requested to stay out of the school grounds. Children will enter the school from the gate at the crossing closest to the MPR (drop off zone) to meet their teacher. A roll call will be taken then. After 10 minutes the grades, with their teacher, will go through the office into the building to their own classrooms. Children who arrive early will need to stay with their parents in their cars until the nominated time. If late, the children will have to wait with parents until all children have gone with their teacher and the remaining staff member can escort the children inside. If a Prep student has a sibling both can enter

the school grounds at once, e.g. A Prep child has a Grade 2 sibling. The Grade 2 child will wait for his/her teacher on the basketball court.

At the end of the day, times for pick up will be staggered as outlined below. Students will be dismissed by their teacher at the same gate. All other gates will be locked. Please wait outside the grounds and in the car park keeping your social distance from each other. Please BE ON TIME for pickup. Students will be allowed to leave when they see their parent/carer in the car park. If you wish to pick up your children earlier than your allocated time you must call the office beforehand. This must be before 2.30pm. No extra pickups will be between 2.30pm and 3.30pm. If you are late the children will be taken back into the building and you will need to phone the office so that they can be brought outside the gate to you after 3.30pm.

If it is raining entry for students will be via the admin office.

Teachers will not be able to speak to parents over the fence as they have a duty of care for the children in their grades. All discussions with teachers for the remainder of the term will need to be via phone or online.

Students who have already been approved to be supervised at school are to follow the same arrangement as previous weeks. They will enter via the front door.

Break times will also be staggered during the day so that the children can keep their social distancing while outside. Children will play in designated areas. Hand sanitiser will be available in all classrooms.

Student reports

Student reports will still be completed for Semester 1, however, they will look different to previous semesters. Due to remote learning there will be no 5 point scale to show where your children are working. The revised report will give parents a general outline of what has been covered this semester in all curriculum areas, information in Reading, Writing and Number on what your child has demonstrated in their learning and what is next in terms of future learning. There will also be a general comment and information on each child's Personal and Social Capabilities and Work Habits. Reports will be sent home with the students on the last day of term.

Virtual school tours will remain in place for next week. Ben has done an amazing job with these. One prospective parent asked Ben if he was sure he wasn't a salesman instead of an Assistant Principal as he had done a wonderful job © Face to face school tours will resume from Monday 1st June by appointment only.

If you have a child starting Prep next year we would appreciate you completing the enrolment forms before the end of this term. We need to know how many places to keep for students of siblings currently attending school.
